

Ocean County Teen Arts Festival

Festival Guidelines

- Students must be 13 - 19 years old.
- Plan to arrive between 7:45 - 8:15am. Check-in will take place in the Grunin Center. A Welcome Session to review the day will begin at 8:30am in the Theatre, and Adjudications and Workshops begin promptly at 9:00am.
- The schedule and time limits will be strictly followed. Be early/on-time to each adjudication. Adjudication schedules will be published online by Wednesday, March 15, 2017.
- Signs will be posted during the festival, directing students to buildings.
- The Larson Student Center will be open and students will be able to purchase or bring their lunch.
- Students may request multiple adjudications as the schedule permits. All students participating in the festival are entitled to at least one adjudication. Multiple requests for adjudication for the same student may be permitted depending on the submissions received.
- Students in all disciplines will have the opportunity for selection to go on to the 2017 NJ State Teen Arts Festival for additional adjudication from professionals in the field. Schools will be notified immediately following the county festival if their students received a nomination for the state event. The **NJ State Festival** is offering several monetary scholarships for advanced arts education. One finalist in each of 8 disciplines from the **NJ State Festival** will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship.
- School registration for the state festival is completely separate from the Ocean County Teen Arts Festival.
- The Ocean County Teen Arts Festival reserves the right to take photographs and video of students, all art work and activities during the festival. These images will become property of the Ocean County Teen Arts Festival.
