

# Ocean County Teen Arts Festival

## Visual Arts Guidelines (2D and 3D)

- Students will be adjudicated individually.
- All visual arts students will be adjudicated during one time period for each school, depending on the number of entries from your school.
- Visual art educators MUST be responsible for labeling each entry, using the Visual Art Labels from the Ocean County Teen Arts Festival Forms page.
- **\*\*NEW\*\* Visual Art Labels may NOT be handwritten.** Please type in fillable PDF file and print.
- Unlabeled student art can get lost; please do not let that happen to your students' work. The Ocean County Teen Arts Festival is not responsible for unlabeled pieces.
- No more than (18) 2-D and (5) 3-D pieces per school. Space is limited.
- One entry per student.
- Visual art will be displayed in the Grunin Center Art Gallery and connecting hallways.

### 2-D Entries:

- All 2-D pieces must be equipped for hanging with either a wire or a hanging apparatus that works with a hook.
- Hanging apparatus cannot consist of string or wire affixed to the work with tape.
- Do not use glass on framed pieces; Plexiglas is allowed.

### 3-D Entries:

- Consider 18"x18"x18" (or smaller) to be the standard size. Larger pieces will be allowed on a limited basis.
- Use your judgement if students are bringing fragile or heavy pieces. Provide your own signage for any fragile pieces. Art work will be in the hallways and are susceptible to damage by passersby.

### SET- UP and TAKE-DOWN:

- Visual Art Educators are required to set up their students' work during March 5 - 9, 2018 between 9am and 4pm in the Grunin Center Art Gallery.
- You must label each piece with the Ocean County Teen Arts labels. Each artwork will have one label attached to back or bottom and one label for display. Labels can NOT be handwritten - they must be typed. \*Work does get lost if you don't label work or labels fall off. The Ocean County Teen Arts Festival is not responsible for lost or stolen works of art while on display at Ocean County College.
- Visual Art MUST stay up for the duration of the festival. Pieces can be taken home on Friday, April 20, 2018 or Monday, April 23, 2018. Take-Down times are between 9am and 4pm.
